#### Dibru College:

The Dibru College established in 1963 and is situated just on the outskirts of Dibrugarh town which is a rural area under the Lahoal Constituency. It is 7 K.m. from the airport and 2 K.m. away from the railway station. The total area of the college is 1.98 acres. It has all the three faculties viz: Arts, Science and Commerce. There are two sections Morning and Day with total student strength of around two thousand. The student pattern of the institution is such that 80% of its enrollment belongs to either ST/SC or OBC/MOBC communities. The college has a fully furnished Library, Gymnasium, Canteen, Day Care Centre, and Student Union office. Established in 1980, the Dibru College Staff Cooperative society (Registered under Societies Regulation Act) which is a nonprofit organization has been instrumental for the welfare of teaching and nonteaching staff members. It has been highly praised by the NAAC peer team. The Department of Biotechnology, Government of India sponsored Bio-Tech. Hub has been established in the college in 2011. In addition to regular courses the college also imparts professional courses on computer skill.

## Call for Papers

#### Concept note:

The 21st century faces unprecedented environmental changes, from climate change and urbanization to changes, from climate change and urbanization to deforestation and biodiversity loss. The contemporary environmental problems and vulnerability of human beings to disasters demand immediate steps to protect our planet and species. The mistreatment of planet results in rapid increase of environmental problems.

The Royal Society and the US National Academy of Sciences (2020) mention that the Carbon Dioxide level in 2019 was more than 40% higher than it was in the 19th century. The report provides that if emission continues on their present trajectory, without either technological or regulatory abatement, then warming of 2.6°C to 4.8°C (4.7 to 8.6 F) in addition to that which has already occurred would be expected during the 21st century. The Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC, 2022) in its 6th assessment report mentions that under 2°C warming scenario, the areas burnt by wildfires would warming scenario, the areas burnt by wildfires would increase by 35% globally as compared to today. Valentina Bellesi and Hugh Miller (2022) provides that after a summer-breaking temperatures, droughts, wildfires and floods causing devastation across the globe, the need to rapidly scale-up finance and investment to support a lowemission and climate resilient transition could not be more apparent. The authors also mention that there are significant gaps between financial actors, Net Zero commitments and the emissions of their portfolios. Nonetheless, the demand for development and preference of climate stand at opposite angles. Growing population and rising need of human beings force to access natural and rising need of numan beings force to access natural resources. Speedy development results in rapid destruction of climate and its frequent changes. Confronting today's environmental challenges requires cooperation and commitment from all sections of society. The rapid degradation of environment draws the attention towards rethinking the governance on environmental sustainability and its conservation.

Organizers hope that the discussions and deliberations during the seminar will come out with concrete action plans and remedial measures to some extent to resolve the issue of conflict between environmental problems and climate issues.

## How to reach Duliajan:

Duliajan College is located at the heart of the Duliajan and about 47 k.m. from Dibrugarh. It is well connected with Air, Train and Bus services. Mohanbari airport, Dibrugarh is approximately 43 k.m. while Duliajan railway station is nearly 3 k.m. away from Duliajan College. New Tinsukia Railway station is the nearest railway junction and it is about 24 k.m. from the college.

#### Guidelines for Submission

All the submission of the papers must be MS Word format, typed in Times New Roman, 12 font sizes, space 1.5 cm and APA style of referencing. An Abstract of the Seminar paper should not exceed more than 300 words with 4-5 keywords. Full paper should adhere to the words limit 2500-3500 and 2 hard copies to be submitted at the time of registration. For manuscript written in Assamese, Ramdhenu software for typing (Font Style – Gitanjali, Font Size – 13.5) can be used.
