RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR PARTICIPANTS

We are delighted to welcome you to the Dibrugarh University Inter College Youth Festival, 2025-26, hosted by Duliajan College, Dibrugarh, scheduled from 28th January to 31st January 2026. To ensure smooth functioning and a memorable experience for all, participants are requested to adhere to the following rules and regulations:

1. Registration and Fees Registration Fee

Rs. 1500 per participant, including other accompanists. Each college must pay Rs. 1000 as a refundable security deposit. No refunds will be issued for cancellations or absences.

2. Accommodation

Accommodation will be provided within the college campus and nearby areas from 27th January to 31st January 2026. Participants must check in on January 27th and vacate the premises by early morning on February 1st, 2026. Accommodation will be provided to maximum 30 participants from a college including teacher in-charge and accompanists. Each college team will be assigned specific rooms. The allocation is final and non-transferable.

3. Code of Conduct

- Participants are expected to maintain discipline and decorum throughout the festival.
- Any form of misbehaviour, including vandalism, harassment, or disruption of events, will lead to disqualification and forfeiture of the security deposit.
- Consumption of alcohol, smoking, or any other intoxicants is strictly prohibited on campus.
- The participants must maintain cleanliness and save the environment of the college campus.

4. Event Participation

- Each participant must carry a valid college ID card throughout the event.
- Teams should report to the event venues at least 30 minutes before the scheduled time.
- Late arrivals may not be allowed to participate in the events.

5. Property and Security

Participants are responsible for their personal belongings. The college will not be liable for any loss or damage. Any damage to college property will result in a penalty, deducted from the security deposit. Entry to restricted areas is strictly prohibited.

6. Medical Assistance

Basic first aid and medical assistance will be available on campus. Participants must inform the organizers of any pre-existing medical conditions at the time of registration.

7. Teacher In-charge

Each college must designate a teacher in charge who will act as the official point of contact between the team and the organizing committee. The teacher in-charges must accompany the team throughout the festival and ensure compliance with the rules.

8. General Instructions:

- Teams should bring their own sleeping materials for a comfortable stay during the event.
- The organizing committee will endeavour to arrange a sufficient number of mattresses, which participants can rent on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Teams are encouraged to carry their own toiletries and other essentials for the stay.
- Proper attire should be maintained during all events and ceremonies.
- Participants must cooperate with the organizing team and follow all instructions provided.

9. An emergency contact number will be provided during the orientation session on 27th January 2026.

10. By registering for the event, participants agree to comply with these rules and regulations. The organizing committee reserves the right to make amendments or additions to the rules, which will be communicated promptly.
