Organized by: Department of Psychology in collaboration with Wellbeing Oasis Club, Duliajan College

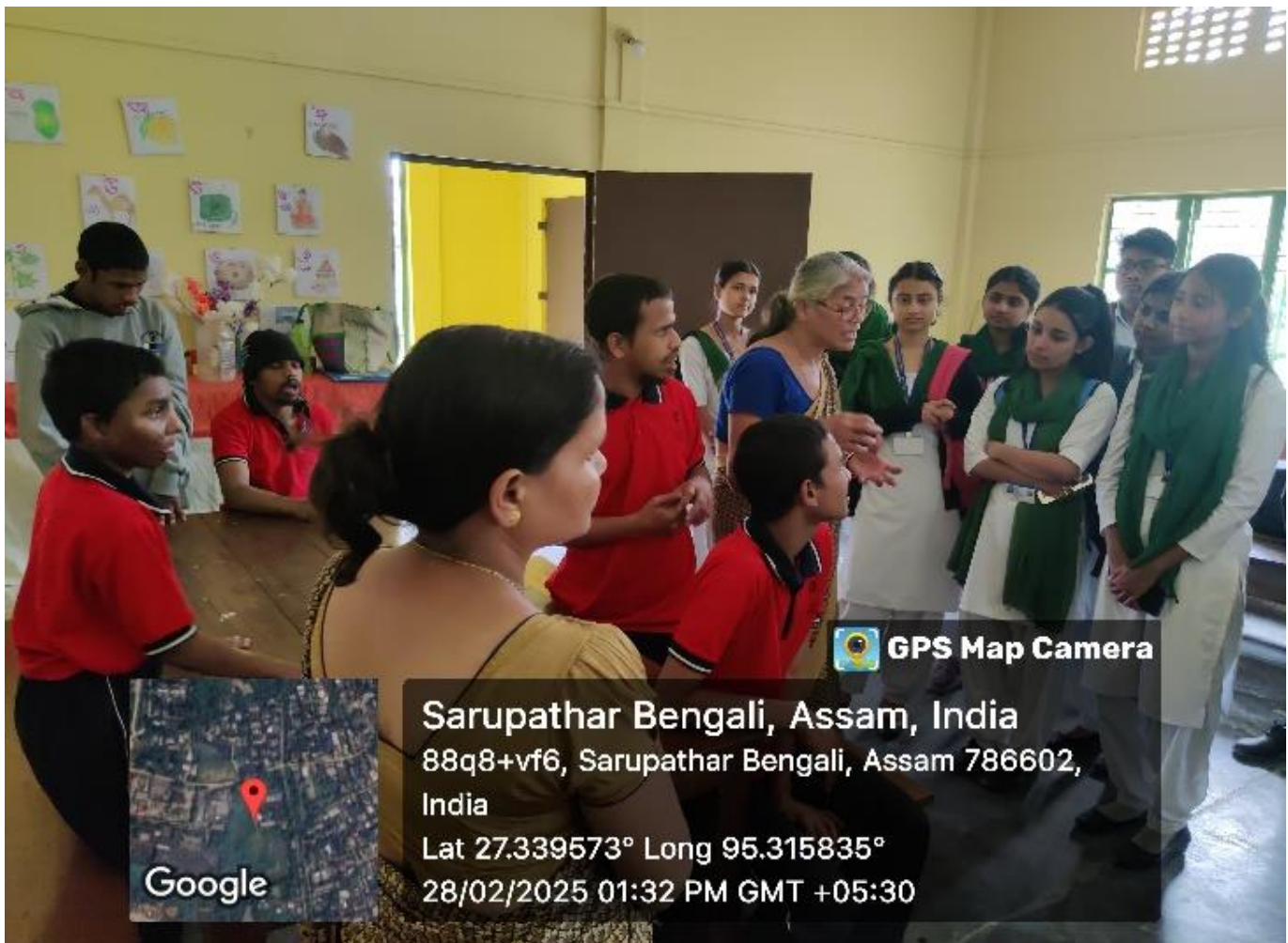
Aims: To observe how rehabilitation programs address the unique needs of girls, boys and gender-diverse individuals with disabilities.
