

Almost all the buildings of the college have good availability of natural light and sufficient ventilations, due to which the college is able to minimize the use of electricity.




The College has a large number of species of herbs growing naturally.




In order to reduce the use of paper in printing official notices etc. the College has installed one LCD screens to communicate with students and faculty.
