


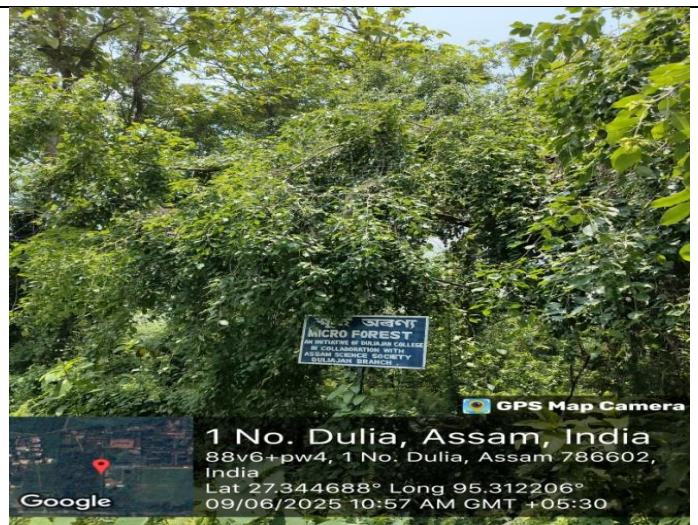
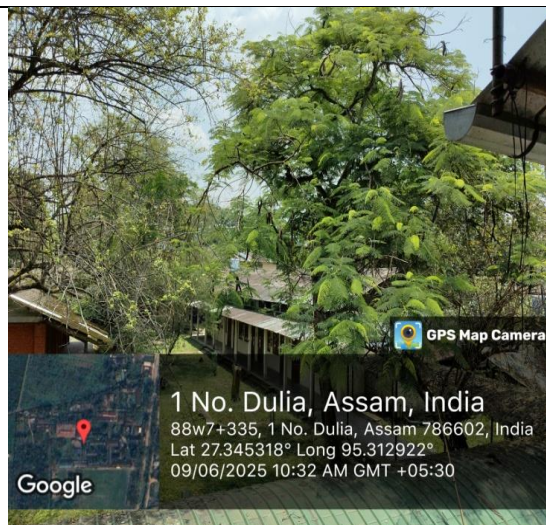
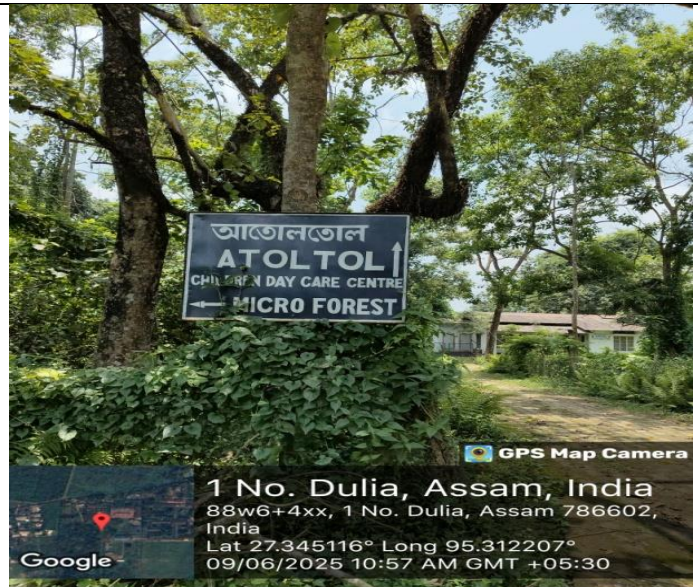
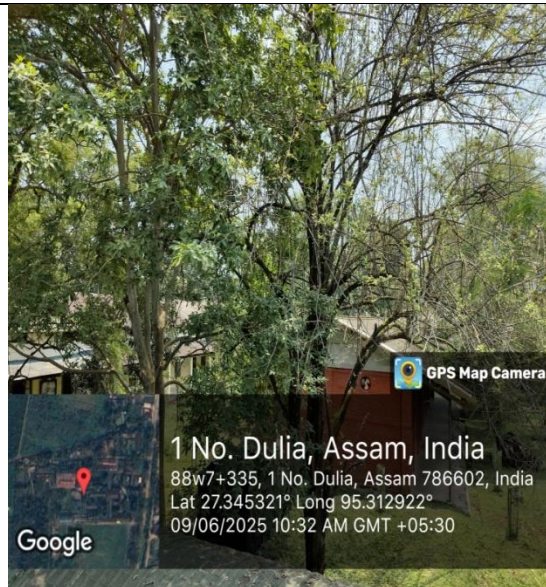
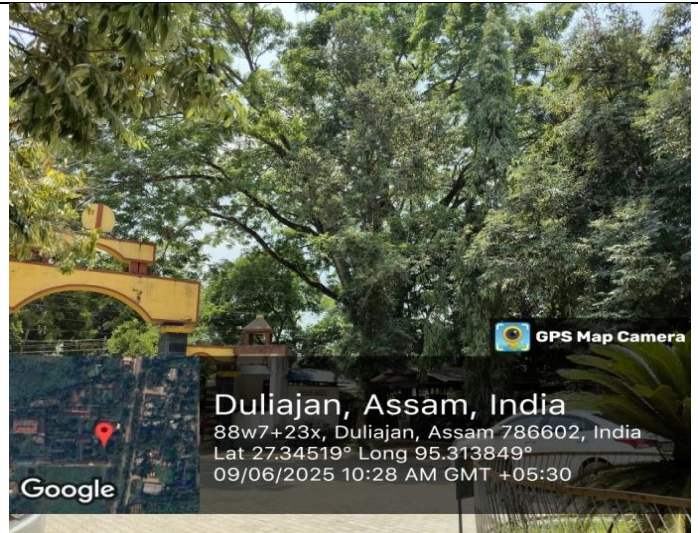
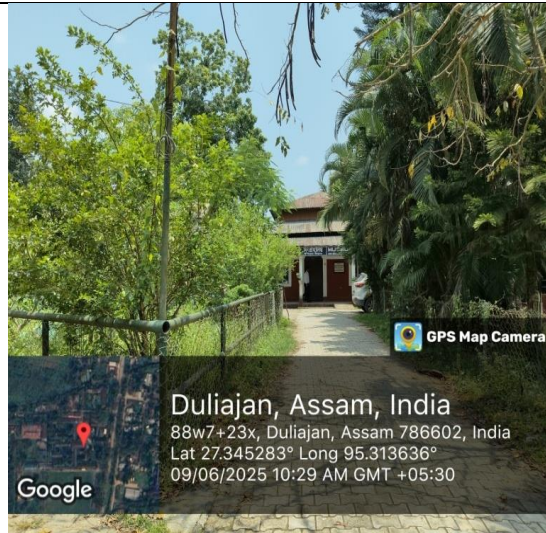








Environmental Initiatives:

	<p>The entire College campus has green cover and at present the College has more than 400 large trees.</p>	



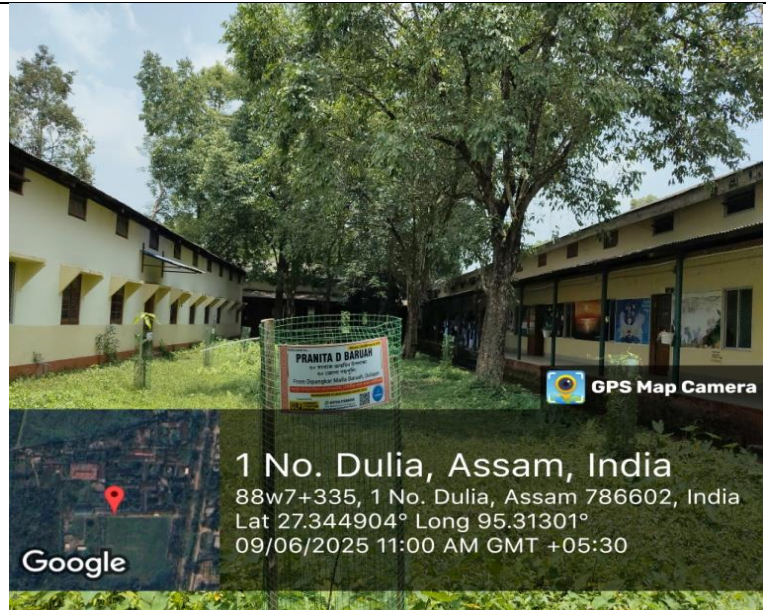

Efforts for Carbon Neutrality

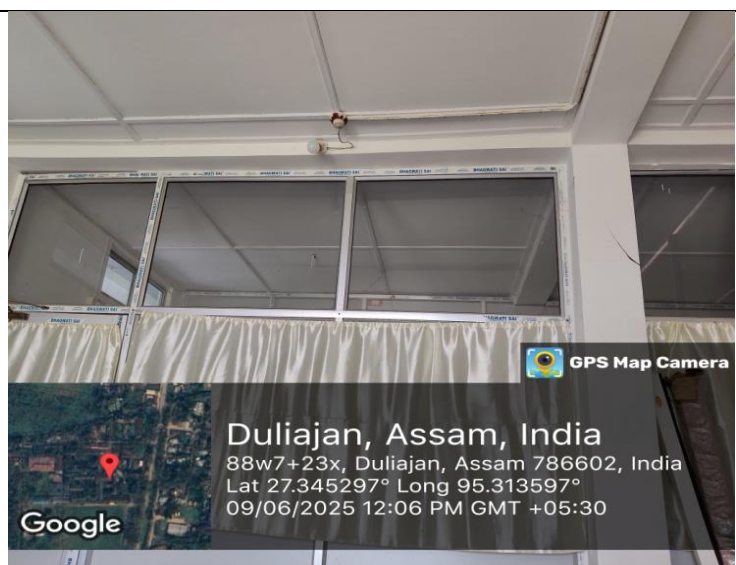
The College has a large number of species of herbs growing naturally.



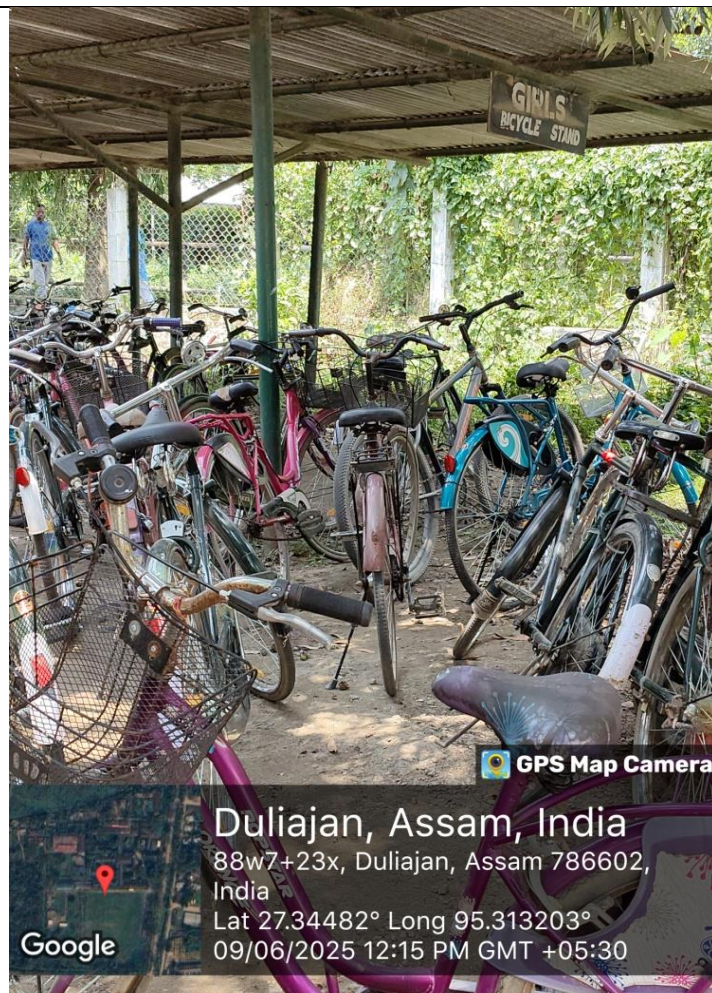
In order to reduce the use of paper in printing official notices etc. the College has installed one LCD screens to communicate with students and faculty.
